UNOPS Pre-qualification process

What is a Pre-qualification Process (PQ)?



- A formal process where supplier appraisal is done prior to issuing the solicitation documents.
- A method of assessing suppliers against predetermined criteria and only suppliers who meet established criteria are invited to tender.
- The process guarantees that solicitation documents are extended only to suppliers with adequate capabilities and resources.
- The end result of a PQ process is a <u>roster of</u> organizations qualified to perform a specific service.

Pre-qualification in PSC





- A general assessment of an organization's technical, organizational and financial capabilities in relation to a specific PSC Technical Category.
- As a default, only Pre-Qualified organizations will be invited to bid/tender for a specific contract in PSC.
- In some circumstances, a tender may be openly advertised. If so, Pre-Qualified companies will be waived from submitting background documentation already been assessed as part of the PQ.



Register with the United Nations Global Marketplace (UNGM) Respond to the PSC Pre-qualification Process once posted in UNGM Review the requirements and submit all documentation stipulated in the PQ Notice

Organizations will be notified of the results upon completion of the evaluation Respond to any clarifications, if contacted by PSC during the evaluation stage PSC PQ panel reviews submissions received

Some aspects are PASS-FAIL
 Some aspects are scored with a minimum score required

PQ certificate is issued by PSC to successful organizations (valid for 2 years with a possibility of extension)
